ECONOMICS

ECON 101.ECONOMICS IN SOCIETY

Provide students with both microeconomic and macroeconomic analytical perspective to think critically about the market system and social objectives it may serve. Topics include the basics of the market economy, market structure, unemployment, inflation, trade, and monetary policy. (General Education – Behavioral and Social Perspectives) *Three credit hours*.

ECON 369.SPECIAL TOPICS IN ECONOMICS

This course allows for the study of various economics topics that are not a part of the regular course offerings. Special topics will be announced in advance and this course may be repeated for additional credit as the topic changes. To repeat the course to improve a grade, the topic, the course number, and the credit hours must be the same. *One to three credit hours.*
