SPAN 200-level or above (24 credit hours): SPAN 205, SPAN 215, SPAN 240, SPAN 280, SPAN 320, SPAN 340, SPAN 345, SPAN 350, SPAN 355, SPAN 360, SPAN 365, SPAN 380, SPAN 480, or SPAN 490.

Course Information: Spanish courses with numbers ending in "7" are given in English and do not count toward the Spanish major or minor.

**The World Cultures requirement will be waived for students who spend a semester on an approved study abroad program, but each student must still earn the minimum number of credit hours required for a degree (a total of 120 credit hours).

Study abroad is strongly encouraged but not required for the Spanish major. Lander offers numerous opportunities for a semester. During a semester abroad, students typically earn up to half of the required credit hours for the Spanish major.

General Education: A student must take courses from two different disciplines in the following General Education categories: Behavioral and Social Perspectives; Humanities and Fine Arts; and Scientific and Mathematical Reasoning.
