**Art History: (3 credit hours):** ARTH 316, ARTH 318, ARTH 319, ARTH 320, ARTH 321, ARTH 325, ARTH 371, ARTH 372 (ARTH 372 can only be counted once toward Art History hours)

#### Course Information

Coursework includes 75 semester hours of major program requirements (includes 26 semester hours of teacher certification requirements).

Coursework must include at least 30 hours earned in 300 or above level courses, of which 12 hours must be in the major

\* Course is only offered once per year, either in fall or spring.

\*\* Course is only offered once per 2 years, either in fall or spring

#### GPA/Grade Req:

Earn "C" or better in 100-level art courses before proceeding to the sophomore studio courses. Students in Art Education must maintain a GPA of 2.75 in the teacher certification requirements.

#### General Education

Students must earn a "C" or better in all professional education, in all major program courses, and in ENGL 101 and ENGL 102.

A student must take courses from two different disciplines in the following General Education categories: Behavioral and Social Perspectives; Humanities and Fine Arts; and Scientific and Mathematical Reasoning.
